

The American Rescue Plan Difference for Florida

Unemployment Rate: <u>Florida's unemployment rate has fallen from 4.8%</u> in January to 4.5% in November.

Unemployment Claims: <u>Florida unemployment claims are down 86%</u> <u>under Biden.</u>

Jobs Created: 467,700 jobs added in Florida under Biden.

New Businesses Started: <u>216,460 New Businesses started in Florida so far this year.</u>

Restaurants Kept Open: <u>Rescue Plan helped 5,706 Florida restaurants</u> <u>stay open – with an average award of \$235,025 per restaurant.</u>

Economic Impact Payments: <u>Florida families received 11.5 million</u> <u>Economic Impact Payments – \$26.5 billion in direct relief.</u>

Monthly Child Tax Credit: <u>Monthly CTC payments for Florida families</u> of 3,660,000 children – with an average monthly payment for each family of \$429 – and \$5.7 billion total paid in monthly payments.

Reducing Health Insurance Costs: <u>Rescue plan saved Florida ACA</u> <u>Marketplace Enrollees \$40 per month – reducing premiums by 48%.</u>

Funds for K-12 Schools: \$7 billion in relief to Florida K-12 public schools – helping schools reopen and address Learning Loss.

State and Local Fiscal Support: <u>Rescue Plan is providing Florida state</u> and local governments with \$15.9 billion in fiscal relief.
