Why Your Vote Matters

No matter where you live across the globe, your vote in the 2024 presidential election will be decisive. In 2020 voters from abroad were essential in ensuring that Georgia and Arizona went for Biden-Harris, and ensured other down ballot victories. In 2024 your vote will again play a major role in shaping the direction of the United States. The results of this election impact Americans worldwide, with effects ranging from health care access and economic stability to retirement and tax policy, not to mention long term effects on our international policies, both political and economic. Voting for Democrats will help continue the progress that Kamala Harris and Tim Walz are fighting for. Every vote counts, especially yours!

How to Cast Your Ballot from Abroad

Casting your ballot while living abroad is straightforward. Follow these steps to ensure your vote is counted:



• Step 1: Register to Vote & Request Your Ballot

Start by requesting your overseas absentee ballot. Go to <u>VoteFromAbroad.org</u> (VFA) to fill out the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA). The FPCA will also register you to vote if needed and it provides you with specific protections under Federal law, including the ability to receive your ballot electronically if you wish. Be sure to select the option to receive your ballot by email for faster processing.

• Step 2: Complete & Return Your Ballot

Once your ballot arrives, complete it according to the instructions provided by your state, which will be shown on the VFA FPCA final page. Return your ballot as early as possible to account for any delays, especially if you're returning it by mail. Most states allow you to return your ballot by email, fax, or online upload, but check your state's guidelines for the quickest option.

If there's a chance your ballot might not arrive in time to meet your state's deadlines, submitting an FPCA also allows you to use the <u>Federal Write-In</u> <u>Absentee Ballot (FWAB)</u> as a backup ballot.

• Step 3: Confirm Your Ballot Was Counted

After submitting your ballot, check with your local election office to ensure that it was received and accepted. You can track the status of your ballot through the <u>links to your state's website on VFA</u>.

• If you have any questions about voting from abroad or if you have any problems with your ballot being accepted, contact Vote From Abroad's Voter Support and Voter Protection Teams at <u>Help@votefromabroad.org</u>. We will work with you and your election officials to try to resolve the issue.
