<b>- 2018 -</b>	
<b>August</b>	Delegate Selection Rules and Call for the Convention adopted by the DNC
<b>December</b>	By December 21 - Delegate Selection Documents (Rules, Call, Regulations, Model Plan and Checklist) distributed to State and Territorial Parties
<b>- 2019 -</b>	
<b>January - April</b>	State Parties draft and adopt Delegate Selection Plans (30-day public comment period on Plans required before adoption)
<b>March</b>	March 1 - Deadline for State Party Affirmative Action Committees to be appointed
<b>May</b>	May 3 - State Delegate Selection Plans due to RBC
<b>June - September</b>	RBC meets to review and take action on State Plans
<b>Mid-September-December</b>	By September 13 - RBC takes final action on all State Plans and States begin implementing Affirmative Action Plans and Outreach and Inclusion Programs  State Parties begin education on the delegate selection process in their state
<b>- 2020 -</b>	
<b>January</b>	Delegate and other convention participants candidate filing begins
<b>February</b>	Pre-window primaries and caucuses hold their contests (Iowa caucuses, New Hampshire primary, Nevada caucuses and South Carolina primary)
<b>March</b>	March 3-Window opens for all states to hold their primary or caucus
<b>June</b>	June 9-Window closes for all states to hold their primary or caucus  June 20- All official Convention participants to be selected ( <i>delegates, alternates, standing committee members, pages, and delegation chair</i> )
<b>June &amp;/or July</b>	Convention standing committees (Credentials, Platform & Rules) meet
<b>July 13-16, 2020</b>	2020 Democratic National Convention
